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"Harlem Toile de Jouy is a celebration of Black culture, and I loved the idea of creating an heirloom that can be passed down for generations to come," Bridges told *Good Housekeeping*. "The collection pays homage to Harlem's exuberant history and, through the partnership with Le Creuset, the pattern can be celebrated every day."

The assortment's classic color choices — black and white — are intentional, too. "The pattern is set in a crisp black appliqué on Le Creuset's white cookware, making it perfect to pair with a range of design aesthetics," Bridges shared.

So after impressive partnerships, ranging from a Harlem Toile speaker with Sonos to silk kaftans, robes and turbans for Gingerlily, why did Bridges decide to share her work with Le Creuset? "Their products stand the test of time in both function and design, and when I'm not actively cooking, I leave them out on display for pops of color throughout my kitchen," she says.
