Interior designer Sheila Bridges is celebrating the cultural mecca that is Harlem and all its rich [African American history](#)—the music, the art, the activism—in one provocative print. After an unsuccessful search for the perfect 18th-century pastoral-themed print known as toile to use in her home, she decided to create her own. That is how her Harlem Toile de Jouy, a pattern that confronts deep-rooted African American stereotypes, was born.

While the pattern holds profound significance, it also happens to be stylish. “I call Harlem Toile the ‘[little black dress](#) of pattern’ because it is really a versatile design that you can mix with any style of decor,” says Bridges, who is known for her classic yet modern interiors that mix contemporary pieces with antiques. “I love pattern-play and layering with classic shapes, colorful patterns, and timeless textiles,” she says. You’ll find her Harlem Toile de Jouy wallpaper both in prominent museum collections and personal residences—it even happens to line the walls in the home of our very own Gayle King! Since creating this print, Bridges continues to broaden its scope, and it has graced everything from glassware to umbrellas. And now she’s spreading the love with three new collabs.

“It’s extremely exciting to expand the Harlem Toile brand, and it has always been my intention since its inception 17 years ago,” Bridges explains. In addition to refreshing her existing [Wedgwood collection](#), she has joined forces with Gingerlily, known for its luxe bedding; cookware heavyweight Le Creuset; and the king of all things kitchen: Williams Sonoma. “I want to continue to collaborate with brands that are authentic to my own life and lifestyle—specifically brands that are associated with great design, functionality, and beauty; and all four of these licensing partners fit that description.” Scroll on to check out the goods.
